### ABOUT OUR SPEAKER

Thomas A. Gorczynski, EA, USTCP is a nationally recognized speaker and educator on federal tax law matters. He is the author of the <u>Tom Talks Taxes</u> newsletter, the co-author of the <u>PassKey Learning</u> <u>Systems EA Review Series</u>, and co-owner of <u>Compass Tax Educators</u>.

He is an Enrolled Agent, a Certified Tax Planner, a National Tax Practice Institute (TM) Fellow, a Certified Tax Resolution Specialist, and admitted to the bar of the United States Tax Court as a non-attorney.

Tom earned a Master of Science in Taxation from Golden Gate University and a Certificate in Finance and Accounting from the Wharton School at the University of Pennsylvania. He received the 2019 Excellence in Education Award from the National Association of Enrolled Agents and the 2018 Member of the Year Award from the American Institute of Certified Tax Planners.

Tom's tax practice in Phoenix, Arizona focuses on implementing advanced tax reduction strategies and representing taxpayers with complex tax problems before the IRS and the US Tax Court.

### CONFERENCE TOPICS

### S-CORPORATIONS: FROM START TO FINISH (6 CPE)

This comprehensive overview of S corporations discusses entity formation, S election requirements, operations, return preparation, stock basis, stock disposition, and tax planning opportunities. Learning objectives: Describe the tax consequences of forming an S corporation. Explain the steps required to make a timely or late S corporation election. Describe the tax consequences of S corp operations to both the corp and the shareholder. Determine the proper entries for an accurate S corporation return. Calculate a shareholder's basis in S corporation stock. Calculate the tax consequences of disposing of S. corporation stock.

### STATUTES OF LIMITATIONS (2 CPE)

The Internal Revenue Code imposes time limits on both the IRS and taxpayers to take certain tax-related actions. This course will review in-depth the three main statutes of limitations—assessment, collection and refund—and use examples frequently encountered in practice to demonstrate key statute of limitations principles. Learning objectives: Describe the assessment statute of limitations and exceptions to the general rule. Describe the collection statute of limitations and exceptions to the general rule. Describe the refund statute of limitations and exceptions to the general rule. Understand how the statute of limitations can resolve a tax controversy.

### NON-FILERS: HELPING TAXPAYERS GET INTO COMPLIANCE (2 CPE)

This course provides an overview of how to get a taxpayer into filing compliance when he or she has failed to file all required federal tax returns. In addition, participants will learn about the authority of the IRS to prepare substitute for return assessments and how those assessments impact non-filers. Learning objectives: Demonstrate how to outline a strategy for getting a non-filer into compliance. Explain IRS Policy Statement 5-133 and its effect on compliance. Describe common issues faced by non-filers, such as incomplete records. Understand the substitute for return process, especially as it relates to non-filers.

### CONFERENCE TOPICS, continued

### FEDERAL TAX UPDATE: INDIVIDUALS & BUSINESSES & THE CORPORATE TRANSPARENCY ACT (CTA) (4 CPE)

This course reviews key tax law changes and trends that impact the taxation of individuals and businesses in the past year. This will include an overview of The Corporate Transparency Act (CTA) which established federal information reporting requirements for certain types of corporations, limited liability companies, and other entities created in or registered to do business in the United States. Learning objectives: Describe how new tax legislation enacted by Congress impacts individual and business taxation. Explain how new IRS guidance and court cases impact individual and business taxation. Describe how existing tax law principles apply to new trends applicable to individuals and businesses.

### SECTION 1031 EXCHANGES (2 CPE)

Real estate investors can use Section 1031 to defer gain on the sale or exchange of real property. This course will detail Section 1031 exchange mechanics and the tax results of using Section 1031 to the taxpayer. The use of Section 1031 in tax planning will also be discussed. Learning objectives: Describe how a real estate exchange qualifies for Section 1031 deferral. Calculate the tax results of a typical Section 1031 exchange to the taxpayer. Explain what constitutes real property for Section 1031 purposes.
